We are delighted to announce the partial re-opening of the Club effective from July  $1^{st}$ , 2020.

This partial re-opening will provide for the following;

- Club meetings, education and training sessions plus Pilates and dance classes can be held in the main upstairs room, subject to the current COVID-19 restrictions.
- The Club gym will be usable by members only, again with clearly signposted COVID-19 restrictions for all gym users.
- The bar and Sunday SIPS will first re-open on Sunday July 19th.


#### **AGM**
