A Bit of History

Members are probably not aware that North Avoca was the first club on the Central Coast to have a Nipper program, known as the North Avoca Sandcrabs, which formed in 1965.

They contested the first ever State Titles at Bulli in 1966 with 29 other Clubs and were the only Central Coast Club represented.

Our best results were the March Past team coming 4th and our 12-year-old 'Chariot Team' also coming in 4th.

The following year saw other Central Coast clubs formed and the first ever Branch Titles, where our March Past team were the undisputed Champions!!

North Avoca Surf lifesaving Club - COVID-19 Update

If you are visiting the Sunday afternoon SIPS at the Club, please be aware that you MUST register using a QR code, and NOT manually. This is a NSW Government regulation for bars and similar facilities that came into effect from the 23rd November. Registration QR codes can be scanned at the bottom and top of the stairs.

This process is pre-populated with some information, so you only need enter you name and mobile number. The information is stored securely with Service NSW and no information is shared with the club.

This does however require you to have the Service NSW App downloaded on your phone. If not, simple pick up a pen and keep registering manually.
