### **Change Rooms**

We are updating our change room policies to be compliant with Surf Lifesaving Australia's Child Safe Policy (available here <u>Child Safe Policy</u>). Can all members please note the following:

1. Children must be supervised by a parent or carer when using the club changerooms.

This means at a minimum parents must remain within earshot of the change room. Please don't send children up to use the change rooms on their own whilst you stay on the beach.

2. Adults, please don't undress in front of children.

If you are using the change rooms at the same time as children, you can shower in your swimwear and change under a towel (just as most of us do after training at Terrigal Haven).
