All other members who have a key, please return to the office. When tapping your FOB, tap in the centre of the black reader pad (not in front of the light display). Ensure that doors are always closed when you leave, and ALL lights have been turned off.

If you lose your FOB, please email <u>office@naslsc.com.au</u> immediately so that it can be deactivated. FOBs are not to be given to other people for use. If you misuse your access your FOB will be deactivated.
