
Season Launch - Saturday 28 September 2024

Lifesaving

Just a reminder that the Patrol season will commence on Saturday 28th September. Please let your patrol captain know if your plans for this season have changed.

Westpac Helicopter – 24hr Chopper Golf Challenge

The Westpac Lifesaver Rescue Helicopter Service commenced in Sydney in 1973. In Northern NSW, the Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service was established two years later in 1975 and has since played a critical role providing emergency aeromedical services 24-7, including search, rescue and inter-hospital transfers.

Each mission flown is only made possible because of the generosity from the community.

In September there is a 24hour golf challenge, like the 24hr Gotta4life rowing event, but each golf player / team does the whole 24hours! There are 13 participants, each hoping to raise vital funds for the helicopter service. One of these players, Darren is not only a long-serving volunteer at NASLSC but also volunteers with the Westpac Rescue Helicopter. Good luck Darren!
